# **AGM Discipline Report season 2023/24**

Bucks Discipline Committee had another busy season, we had an increase from last season. The disappointing issue is the behaviour towards match officials increased, this is being dealt with by Bucks RFU and Discipline Chair as needs to be removed from our game, disrespect and abuse of match officials is not acceptable behaviour.

The concern re world rugby tackle height regulation did not impact as much as expected, only 3 red cards issued at clubs, AGR & schools. Referees managed the situations and only issued Red Cards if needed. Also, coaches & teachers worked hard during the season to improve tackle height to avoid the head-on-head incidents.

Bucks Discipline Panel dealt with the below cases involving Bucks Clubs, plus had 2 Formal hearings heard by RFU Discipline due to seriousness of the cases. The RFU also dealt with a racial & physical abuse against a Bucks player by a Berks player, the case was proved, the player received a large sanction.

Bucks Discipline Panel had a couple of cases that resulted in substantial match bans for players. A club received a 2-match adult level ban from all club male senior rugby teams in leagues/cup games from the start of the 2024/25 season, plus getting a formal warning re future behaviour in the 2024/25 season that could result in a 40-point deduction from 1<sup>st</sup> XV.

Match Official Abuse, unacceptable behaviour by players, coaches, spectators plus entering the field of play without referee permission & getting involved in incidents will not be tolerated by RFU & Bucks Discipline. Hearings could result in substantial sanctions being issued to players, coaches or the club & could result in point deductions to 1<sup>st</sup> XV, if implemented by discipline panels.

In my role as Bucks Age Grade Discipline Sec (CBAG), had 5 club & 1 school sending offs, these were dealt with internally by clubs or Schools, with sanctions issued by both clubs & schools, see below in blue. All AGR sanctions were ratified by RFU AGR Discipline Officer.

### Regulation 19.5.5: Entering the playing area without referee permission.

Discipline has the power to provisionally suspend any individual for a period of up to four weeks if such individual has entered the playing area without the permission of the Referee and is subject to a disciplinary or safeguarding investigation as a result.

### Regulation 12.5: Approaches to Match Officials.

No person (other than the Match Officials team or Match Officials coach) shall approach the Match Officials at any time during the half-time interval and up to 30 minutes after the match to discuss any issue arising from the match nor enter the Referee's changing room unless invited to do so by the Referee.
