This is due to our Club Safeguarding Officers (CSO) doing a sterling job by ensuring our club children are being kept safe. I wish to pass on my thanks to all the CSO's and we have worked hard to educate club what the CSO role & supported them in their role, well done all.

Unfortunately, this season we have had an increase in the amount of unacceptable behaviour from coaches, parents, and spectators. Unfortunately, we have had to formally warn a couple of clubs this season re unacceptable behaviour.

Bucks Clubs have ensured that those working with children have complied with Reg 21, by holding "Play it Safe" CPD Courses. ALL our club safeguarding officers have attended the "In Touch" course.

This season I have delivered "Play it Safe" courses in Bucks, it is really pleasing that so many volunteers have attended, increasing their knowledge & understanding the importance of what is required when working with children, U18's.
